

This is how WeCanCode Community creates WeCanCode Hackathon and WeCanCode Academy, a series of free programming workshops at beginner and intermediate levels.

In past editions, WeCanCode Hackathon has established itself as one of the most important events for programmers in the region, achieving a participation of 120 participants and a presence of around 200 attendees in its 2016 edition.




Youth between 17 and 28 years old




70% of attendees are University students and 30% are professionals.

What Is WeCanCode Hackathon?

During a period of 24 continuous hours, programmers, designers, and entrepreneurs get together in teams to develop their ideas through technology and create a project from scratch. Students and professionals from around the Baja California region will test their knowledge, creativity, and skills to compete for the first place.

In addition, WeCanCode Community provides its own hardware lab where participants can make use of different devices to develop their projects, including Oculus Rift, Drones, 3D printer, Myo, among others. Thus, participants have the advantage of expanding their ideas and creating even more ambitious projects.



In previous events, more than 40 projects have been created, of which the following have won first place:

2014 - It's Broken

Mobile application to detect problems in the city in terms of urbanization, such as potholes, water leaks, etc. and thus give notice to the relevant agencies.

2015 - Edumotion

Virtual chemistry lab using the Oculus Rift SDK for use in elementary schools.

2016 - Bluethalyzer

Breathalyzer that allows to read alcohol levels through a smartphone, which prevents driving if it exceeds the recommended alcohol level.
